8-31-2025 Sunday Sermon Message Meditation of the Week: Psalm 91:1-16

Text: 1 Peter 1:1-25

Title: A Message to the Chosen Ones
Who are chosen through sprinkling
of Jesus Christ

The apostle Peter testified about what kind of life we should live in the last days for Christians who believed in Jesus Christ and were forgiven of their sins by the blood of Christ and were chosen as God's children.

He testified that He gave us a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, and that He had left an inheritance in heaven that was incorruptible, undefiled, and indegradable for us.

In addition, he testified that we are protected by the power of God by faith in order to receive salvation, which He prepared to manifest in the last days.

He testified that in the last days, because of the works of the devil, we can only grieve for a while due to various temptations, but we rejoice greatly because we will become much more precious than gold through the trial of faith, so that we can receive praise, honor, and glory by overcoming all trials with faith on the day of the rapture when Jesus Christ appears.

They also testified of the testimony of saved soul, they had not seen. Christ and that their souls were revealed to

those who were saved, that they had not seen Him, that they loved Him, that they still did not see Him, but that they believed in Him, and that they were able to rejoice in joy filled with indescribable glory.

He also allowed us to explore and prophesy what and what the Spirit of Christ in them will direct when the Spirit of Christ in them bears witness to Christ's suffering and the glory to come, as the prophets diligently examine and examine the grace that will come to us regarding the salvation we have received.

The work of the prophets was not for themselves, but for us, and it was delivered to us through the Holy Spirit and through the evangelists.

They testify that the angels are eagerly hoping for the grace they have given us, but the angels cannot know the grace of becoming God's children through the blood of Jesus Christ.

The Apostle Peter has a very important message for the Church of God, the bride of Christ who is living in the last days and waiting for the rapture:

"Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

14 As obedient children, not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance:
15 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;
16 Because it is written. Be we holy:

16 Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy."(1 Peter 1:13-16)

When Jesus prayed His final prayer on earth, He prayed to sanctify His disciples:

## "Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth."(John 17:17)

Yeah! The holiness that God speaks of is not to show holy on the outside, but to become holy through the act of obeying the word of truth. The apostle Peter testified about this:

"Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently: By obeying the truth through the."(1 Peter 1:22)

It is the truth that when we obey the truth, our souls are purified and sanctified, and when our souls are cleansed, God's disposition, love, is revealed through us.

The Apostle Peter testified about the rebirth:

"Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the

word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

24 For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass.

The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away:

25 But the word of the Lord endureth for ever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you."(1 Peter 1:23-25)

He testified that when we preach the gospel of Christ's grace, those who hear it repent and when they receive Christ Jesus, they are born again through the Holy Spirit.

Therefore, the bride of Christ, who is living a life of a stranger like a pilgrim while waiting for the glorious appearance of Christ Jesus, the blessed hope and great God, should preach the gospel of Christ until the day He appears, become holy by obeying His word, love passionately, practice the love of Christ, and look forward to the grace He gives us to the end.
