9-14-2025 Sunday Sermon Message Meditation of the Week: Psalm 91:1-16

Text: Matthew 6:9-10

Title: God's will for heaven and earth is His

Kingdom!

God the Creator incarnate and told His chosen Israelites, the Jews, to pray for His kingdom to come in heaven and on earth.

After Adam sinned and brought sin, the whole world came under Satan's rule and distributed kingdoms to those who Satan wanted, so that the kingdom of God could not be achieved. They violently took over the heavens and the earth that God Himself created.

However, God planned to restore His kingdom in heaven and on earth, and He told His people, the Jews, to pray for His kingdom to be fulfilled in heaven and on earth.

God has not been in the midst of this work for the past six thousand years, nor has He slept in His sleep. Just as God rested on the seventh day after creating all things for six days, He will work to fulfill His will like six days for the past six thousand years, and when the seventh millennium comes, when He finally establishes His millennial kingdom on earth, He will finally throw the devil into the bottomless oit and establish His kingdom on the earth.

God established the Church of God, which was bought with His own blood by Jews and Gentiles to accomplish His will. Now, sooner or later, after lifting up the Church of God to heaven, He will plan a great tribulation for seven years to judge the Jews and all the Gentile peoples who do not believe in Him, and He will judge the Jews and Gentiles who have not been raptured.

The Great Tribulation of the Seven Years was prepared in advance to refine the Israelites who did not believe in Him and make them repent. The prophet Jeremiah prophesied this time as Jacob's trouble:

"And these are the words that the Lord spake concerning Israel and concerning Judah.

⁵ For thus saith the Lord; We have heard a voice of trembling, of fear, and not of peace.

- ⁶ Ask ye now, and see whether a man doth travail with child? wherefore do I see every man with his hands on his loins, as a woman in travail, and all faces are turned into paleness?
- ⁷ Alas! for that day is great, so that none is like it: it is even the time of Jacob's trouble, but he shall be saved out of it.
- ⁸ For it shall come to pass in that day, saith the Lord of hosts, that I will break his yoke from off thy neck, and will burst thy bonds, and strangers shall no more serve themselves of him:

 ⁹ But they shall serve the Lord their God, and David their king, whom I will raise up unto them."

 (Jeremiah 30:4-9)

The Antichrist wants to exterminate all the Jews like Hitler of old, but God will let them flee and enter his kingdom:

- "And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days... And when the dragon saw that he was cast unto the earth, he persecuted the woman which brought forth the man child.

 14 And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.
- ¹⁵ And the serpent cast out of his mouth water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood.
- 16 And the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed up the flood which the dragon cast out of his mouth.
- 17 And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ."(Revelation 12:6,13-17)

God will bring into his kingdom Gentiles who do not believe in Jesus Christ and enter into the great tribulation, suffering all kinds of hardships and not receiving the mark of the beast:

"After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

- 10 And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb.
- 11 And all the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God,
- 12 Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, be unto our God for ever and ever. Amen.
- 13 And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they?
- 14 And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.
- 15 Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them.
- They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat.
- 17 For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes." (Revelation 7:9-17)

The Gentiles who entered the Great Tribulation repented during the Tribulation, believed in Christ Jesus, and fled to avoid receiving the mark of the beast, and after suffering all kinds of hardships, they met the Lord Jesus Christ who came again and entered His kingdom.

The prophet Isaiah prophesied about the repentant Jews who would finally enter the kingdom of Christ:

- "And they shall build the old wastes, they shall raise up the former desolations, and they shall repair the waste cities, the desolations of many generations.
- ⁵ And strangers shall stand and feed your flocks, and the sons of the alien shall be your plowmen and your vinedressers.
- ⁶ But ye shall be named the Priests of the Lord: men shall call you the Ministers of our God: ye

shall eat the riches of the Gentiles, and in their glory shall ye boast yourselves.

⁷ For your shame ye shall have double; and for confusion they shall rejoice in their portion: therefore in their land they shall possess the double: everlasting joy shall be unto them."(Isaiah 61:4-7)

Meanwhile, the brides of Christ, the Church of God, who were raptured before the Tribulation, will marry Christ in heaven and have a wedding feast during the Great Tribulation for seven years on earth:

"Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready.

8 And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints." (Revelation 19:7-8)

After the wedding feast, the brides of Christ will judge the antichrist, the false prophets, and all the nations with Christ when He returns to earth to establish His Kingdom:

- "And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.
- hat with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God....

And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone. The armies of heaven followed him on white horses, dressed in white and clean linen. those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshipped his image. And they were thrown alive into a lake of brimstone and fiery fire. (Revelation 19:14-15,20)

The brides of Christ who have descended to earth with Christ will have the honor of reigning with him in his kingdom:

"And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;

10 And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth."

11 (Revelation 5:9-10) Hallelujah! Amen!
