Meditation of the Week: Psalm 91:1-16
Text Verse: Hebrews 7:1-3

Title: **The Lord Jesus Christ, king of Righteousness and king of Peace**

When we say that the Lord Jesus Christ is the king of righteousness and the king of peace, it means that no one but the Lord Jesus will justify people and give them eternal peace.

The Bible declares that no one living in the world is righteous:

"As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one:

¹¹ There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God.

¹² They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one.

¹³ Their throat is an open sepulchre; with their tongues they have used deceit; the poison of asps is under their lips:

¹⁴ Whose mouth is full of cursing and bitterness:

¹⁵ Their feet are swift to shed blood:

¹⁶ Destruction and misery are in their ways:

¹⁷ And the way of peace have they not known:

¹⁸ There is no fear of God before their eyes."(Romans 3:10-18)

The unrighteous sins in a person cannot be eliminated by oneself or any other person and made righteous. Because of this, the God of love wanted to make the unrighteous righteous by sending His only Begotten Son into the world to remove the sins of the world. John the Baptist proclaimed to the world about the Lamb Lord Jesus Christ, who takes away the sin of the world:

"The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

³⁰ This is he of whom I said, After me cometh a man which is preferred before me: for he was before me."(John 1:29-30)

Before Jesus was sent as the Lamb to take away the sin of the world, God forgave the Jews under the law by killing the sacrifice that bore their sins and shedding their blood to forgive their sins. But the blood of the animal could not remove the sins from their consciences and justify them. Only the blood of Jesus Christ, God, can remove the sins in them and justify them. The apostle Paul testified to the Hebrews:

" For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect.

² For then would they not have ceased to be offered? because that the worshippers once purged should have had no more conscience of sins.

³ But in those sacrifices there is a remembrance again made of sins every year.

⁴ For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins."(Hebrews 10:1-4)

The apostle Paul also testified of the appearance of the One who finally removes sin:

"Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but a body hast thou prepared me:

⁶ In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin thou hast had no pleasure.

⁷ Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O God.

⁸ Above when he said, Sacrifice and offering and burnt offerings and offering for sin thou wouldst not, neither hadst pleasure therein; which are offered by the law;

⁹ Then said he, Lo, I come to do thy will, O God. He taketh away the first, that he may establish the second.

¹⁰ By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.”(Hebrews 10:5-10)

Only when all sins are removed and sanctified through faith in the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ can we be justified through the righteousness of God. Therefore, only the Lord Jesus Christ can be the King of righteousness.

The apostle Paul testified of the blessings of those who have been removed from their sins and justified:

" Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.

¹³ For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh:

¹⁴ How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?”(Hebrews 9:12-14)

The Lord Jesus Christ alone is the king of Peace, which means that He alone can give the world true and eternal peace. The politicians of the world lie that they will create a peaceful and safe world, but the peace and security they claim are only false peace and security that will make the body feel at ease for

a while, politically and economically. True peace and security are true peace and security that transcends death only when sins are removed, whether we believe in the Lord Jesus Christ and receive the forgiveness of sins through His blood.

Because of this, Jesus told Nicodemus, who came to him, that unless man born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God, and unless he is born of water and the Holy Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. In other words, He said that he should believe in his own blood, receive the righteousness He gives, be born again of the Holy Spirit, and enter the eternal kingdom of God (John 3:3,5)

The apostle Paul testified that only by being born again in the Holy Spirit and entering the spiritual kingdom of God can we live in true righteousness and peace:

"For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

¹⁸ For he that in these things serveth Christ is acceptable to God, and approved of men.”(Romans 14:17-18)

In the last days, politicians in the world are lying that they will make themselves a peaceful and safe world. But when they speak false peace and security, Christ, the Lord of righteousness and peace, will lift His church into heaven and judge those who lie:

"They are safe and secure.'As labor pains come to the woman of the child, sudden destruction will come upon them, and they will never be able to avoid it."(1

Thessalonians 5:3)
