10-26-2025 Sunday Sermon Message Meditation of the Week: Psalm 91:1-16

Text: Romans 6:23

Title: Sin That Leads to Death

God has spoken about the words that people should keep in each age. He also said that not keeping His word is a sin.

In the Garden of Eden, God gave Adam and Eve one word not to eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil in the center of the garden. He also said that on the day you eat it, you will surely die. On the day they ate the fruit of good and evil, their bodies did not die, but their spirits died. Adam's body lived for 930 years and died (Genesis 5:5).

After Adam and Eve were expelled from the Garden of Eden, God did not speak to the people. The apostle Paul testified that the people of that day lived according to the law of their conscience even in the absence of the law:

"For when the Gentiles, which have not the law, do by nature the things contained in the law, these, having not the law, are a law unto themselves:

15 Which shew the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another;)

16 In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel.

<u>Jesus Christ according to my</u>
gospel.(Romans 2:14-16)

After God liberated the Israelites from Egypt, He gave them all the laws and commandments, including the Ten Commandments, on Mount Sinai for them to keep.

Finally, God sent His only begotten Son in the form of a man to be a sacrifice for the sins of the whole world. Through Him He has accomplished eternal redemption for believers:

"But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God;

13 From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool.

14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified." (Hebrews 10:12-14)

Jesus said that after he died on the Cross and was resurrected, the Holy Spirit would come and reprove the world of sin, of righteousness, and of judgment:

"And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

Of sin, because they believe not on me;
 Of righteousness, because I go to my
 Father, and ye see me no more;
 Of judgment, because the prince of this

11 Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged."(John 16:8-11)

Jesus foretold about the need to believe in Himself to receive eternal life:

"And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up:

15 That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life.

16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."(John 3:14-16)

When the Israelites were in the wilderness, they rebelled against Moses and said, Wherefore have ye brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? for there is no bread, neither is there any water; and our soul loatheth this light bread. 'Wherefore have ye brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? for there is no bread, neither is there any water; and our soul loatheth this light bread." (Num. 21:5)

At this time, the Lord sent fiery serpents among the people, and they bitten the people, and many of the Israelites died (Num. 21:6)

When they repented, the Lord said:

"Make thee a fiery serpent, and set it upon a pole: and it shall come to pass, that every one that is bitten, when he looketh upon it, shall live.

At this time, even if the serpent bit a person, he lived when he looked at the brass serpent. They were not resurrected by the power of the brass serpent, but when they repented and obeyed God's word, He saved them.

Jesus said that he would be lifted up on the cross like a pole like the brass serpent of old. Therefore, it is a promise that if you repent of not believing in Jesus and look at and believe in Him who died on the cross and was resurrected, He will give you life. Therefore, in the current age of grace, not believing in Jesus Christ is sin, so we have no choice but to perish, but if we believe, God will give us eternal life.

Therefore, in this age, not believing in Jesus Christ is sin and leads to death, but when we believe in the Lord Jesus Christ, God gives us the gift of eternal life by grace. This is the word of Jesus, who is God, and it gives us the blessing of living forever as long as we believe in ourselves. In other words, He was miserably on the cross like a brass serpent hanging from a pole in the wilderness of old, but if you believe in Him, He will give you the blessing of not perishing. Destruction means that we will not be able to rise forever and will die forever in hellfire.

But modern biotechnologists are insisting through the United Nations that they have created a project for eternal life and believe in it. They do not see the sin in human DNA and claim that people die because of the old cells in them and all kinds of deadly scolding. According to them, those who will survive until 2030 are deceiving people by falsely claiming that Al can make humans live forever at that time. They believe that people can live forever if they remove the deadly things in human cells through surgery to edit DNA in people. However, no matter how much they studied, they could not find the sin in man.

The Lord made it clear:

"<u>of sin because they do not believe in</u> me.(John 16:9)
