Meditation of the Week: Psalm 91:1-16
Text: Isaiah 43:18-21
Title: **God Doing New Things**

God has been and will continue to do new things for the past two thousand years. It is wisdom to know why God does new things and how to do them. The object of God's new work is first of all to the people and the earth that God has created.

If so, we need to know what new work He is doing for people. All people who are born after the sin of the first man, Adam, are born in the loss of the image of God because of sin. God began a new work two thousand years ago to restore man to the image of God. He sent His only begotten Son into the world in the name of Jesus to shed His blood on the Cross, was buried, and then resurrected on the third day to atone for all the sins in the people, so that all those who believed in Him would be reborn by giving them the Holy Spirit. He created us as a new man.

The apostle Paul testified of the new work God has done:

"We too were once fools and disobedience, deceived, enslaved to all kinds of greed and pleasure, living in evil and envy, abominable and hateful of one another, but then the kindness and love of our Savior God toward man was manifested, and he saved us not by the righteous works

we have done, but by the washing of regeneration and the renewal of the Holy Spirit, which he poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour. That we may be justified by his grace and become heirs according to the hope of everlasting life" (Titus 3:3-7).

I do! God died spiritually with Jesus Christ on the cross and raised him again by giving the Holy Spirit to make man new.

God said that when Adam sinned, not only Adam but also the land in which he took Adam was cursed:

"And God said to Adam, 'Because you have listened to the voice of your wife, I commanded you, saying, 'You shall not eat of it.' You have eaten of the fruit of the tree, and the earth will be cursed because of you, and you will eat its fruit from your afflictions during your whole life. And the earth will bring forth thorns and thistles, and you will eat the vegetables of the field, and you will eat bread until you return to the earth, and you will sweat on your face until you return to the earth, for you have been taken from the earth. You are dust, and you will return to dust.' He said. (Genesis 3:17-19)

God said through the prophet Isaiah that God must do a new work to restore the land that has been cursed by man's sin:

"Do not remember the things of the past, do not think of the things of the past. Behold, I will do a new thing, and now I will appear. Do you not know this? Surely I will bring down the roads in the wilderness and the rivers in the desert. The beasts of the field will honor me, and so will the dragons and the owls. For I will give water in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert, so that my people, my chosen ones, may drink from it. These people I have made for me, and they will show my praise.(Isaiah 43:18-21)

God is doing new work to renew the people who have been cursed because of the sins brought about by Satan and the land that has been cursed because of them. First of all, He redeems those who believe in the Savior Jesus Christ with His precious blood and does new things to renew the land where people live.

Jesus told him that he would do the work of renewing the earth until the day he judged the world and sat on the throne of glory:

"Then Peter answered and said to him, 'Behold, we have left everything and followed the Lord. So what do we have? Jesus said to them, 'Verily I say to you, you who follow me will sit on the twelve thrones of Israel in the Regeneration, when the Son of Man will sit on the throne of his glory, and you will also sit on the twelve thrones

and judge the twelve tribes of Israel.(Matthew 19:27-28)

The Regeneration that Jesus spoke to His disciples was that the earth would be born again on the day when Jesus established the millennial kingdom on earth and sat on the throne as the King of kings.

Sooner or later, He will judge all the nations of the earth through the seven-year great tribulation, judge the antichrist and false prophets in the lake of fire, and renew the cursed earth and make them born again.

The Israelites, who hope in God who does new things for the earth, have been singing about the things that will appear when He does new things for a long time.
Amen! Hallelujah!
