Meditation of the Week: Psalm 91:1-16
Text: 2 Peter 2:1-9

Title: **God regretted the creation of man, but turned around and gave great grace to man**

About a thousand years after Adam, God saw the wickedness of people and regretted the creation of man:

" And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.

⁶ And it repented the Lord that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart.

⁷ And the Lord said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them."

" Genesis 6:5-7)

But of the countless people who lived on earth at that time, only one Noah, took grace in the eyes of the Lord:

" These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God."(Genesis 6:9)

He said that because of the wickedness of men, the earth will also be corrupted and full of violence, and

will destroy the people along with the earth:

"And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth." (Genesis 6:13)

How evil has the current world, where 8 billion people live, become in God's eyes? The thoughts and imaginations of all people's hearts became as evil as in the time of Noah. If God does not give grace, not leaving a single person will die and be destroyed.

When Noah, who was saved from the flood, built an altar and offered a burnt offering to the Lord, God said:

"I will not again curse the ground any more for man's sake; for the imagination of man's heart is evil from his youth; neither will I again smite any more every thing living, as I have done."(Genesis 8:21)

God, who regretted the creation of man, still loves the world so much that He decided to save people, and He planned to redeem and remove the evil sins that are rooted in people's consciences with the blood of His Only Begotten Son.

The apostle Paul testified about this plan of salvation:

"Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.

¹³ For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh:

¹⁴ How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?"(Hebrews 9:12-14)

This is why the apostle John testified that God loved the world in this way:

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."(John 3:16)

Even though 8 billion people were judged and had to die, as in the time of Noah, those who do not believe in God, who loved the world and gave His only begotten Son as a sacrifice, cannot escape the final judgment. For this reason, God judges all the nations who do not believe in Christ during the seven-year great tribulation. However, the church of God, which is the body of Christ, is raptured to heaven before the great tribulation.

We must look at the signs that are appearing in the world now and discern that the rapture and the great tribulation are right in front of us.

Under the leadership of the WEF, we hear every day that they are talking about a world of peace and security.

We also see that the mark of the beast made by the antichrist during the Great Tribulation is already appearing before our eyes. Plans have already been made public for a world that controls people all over the world by putting digital IDs and chips in people's heads from 2026.

Also, the world now has become an evil and lewd world, just like the old days of Sodom and Gomorrah. Even then, He rescued only one righteous man, Lot, who was suffering from the lewd deeds of the wicked. The righteous Lot said that it was because his righteous soul suffered because he lived among them and saw and heard their lawless deeds every day.

In this way, we should be eternally grateful for God's grace that He loved us and made us forgiven of our sins and made us born again through the blood of Christ Jesus.
