This Week's Meditation: Psalm 91:1-16  
Text: 1 Thessalonians 5:1-9  
Title of the Message: **God Who Saves Us from Wrath**

Enoch fathered Methuselah at the age of 65 and walked with God for 300 years before God took him away (Genesis 5:22-24)

The Hebrew word Methuselah means that judgment will come after he dies. During the time of Noah, Methuselah's grandson, God was angry and judged by the flood, killing everyone on earth except Noah's family with a great flood.

When God was awakening and judged Sodom and Gomorrah, He saved two daughters who had not married the righteous Lot from His wrath.

The Apostle Paul said, "For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape. ." As they testify, when the Antichrist appears and makes a peace treaty for seven years, they will be deceived by him and say that a world of peace and security has come. At this time, the Lord Jesus Christ will appear and carry God's church into heaven, saving us from wrath.

The prophet Daniel prophesied about what would happen at this time:

**" And through his policy also he shall cause craft to prosper in his hand; and he shall magnify himself in his heart,**

**and by peace shall destroy many: he shall also stand up against the Prince of princes; but he shall be broken without hand."(Daniel 8:25)**

John the Baptist warned the hypocritical religious followers of the time that they would not escape the day of wrath:

**"But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?"(Matthew 3:7)**

The Apostle John foresaw in the Holy Spirit what would happen when the final judgment of wrath came and prophesied through Revelation. However, the church does not appear in Revelation. Because the church has already been raptured.

The Apostle Paul testified to the believers in the Thessalonian church who were waiting for the rapture:

**" But ye, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief.**

**<sup>5</sup>Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness.**

**<sup>6</sup>Therefore let us not sleep, as do others; but let us watch and be sober.**

**<sup>7</sup>For they that sleep sleep in the night; and they that be drunken are drunken in the night.**

**<sup>8</sup>But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and**

**love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation.**

**<sup>9</sup> For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ.”(1 Thessalonians 5:4-9)**

The Apostle Paul also testified about God's church, which will be saved from the wrath:

**“But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.**

**<sup>9</sup> Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.”(Romans 5:8-9)**

The Apostle Paul also testified about those who cannot escape God's wrath:

**“For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness;**

**<sup>19</sup> Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them.**

**<sup>20</sup> For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:”(Romans 1:18-20)**

The Apostle John testified about the things that would happen on the day of God's wrath:

**<sup>12</sup> And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black**

**as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood;**

**<sup>13</sup> And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind.**

**<sup>14</sup> And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.**

**<sup>15</sup> And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;**

**<sup>16</sup> And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:**

**<sup>17</sup> For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand?”(Revelation 6:12-17)**

The Apostle John testified to what Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit, and the Bride say to the world:

**“I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star.**

**<sup>17</sup> And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.”(Revelation 22:16-17)**

The Apostle John delivered a very important message at the end of Revelation:

**"He which testifieth these things saith,  
Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so,  
come, Lord Jesus.**

**<sup>21</sup> The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be  
with you all. Amen.."(Rev. 22:20-21)**
