12-21-2025 Sunday Sermon Message Meditation of the Week: Psalm 91:1-16

Text: Isaiah 9:1-6

Title: <u>Jesus was born into the world</u> <u>as a great light</u>

The prophet Isaiah prophesied that Jesus, their Messiah, who would be born into the world as a great light for Israel, would be born as a child.

He prophesied that there would be a government on his shoulders. He prophesied that He would establish a kingdom and become King of kings. He told the Jews to pray for his kingdom to come and to pray that it would be done on earth as it was in heaven.

He also prophesied that his name would be a marvelous one. God Himself was conceived in the womb of the virgin Mary with the Holy Spirit, and was nurtured in it for nine months, and was born into the world as a complete baby. He who is God grew up feeding on Mary's milk and wearing diapers, and He is truly a wonderful person. He also did not call Mary a mother, but a woman.

He was a true counselor. A counselor is a person who solves all people's problems. However, there is no counselor in the world who can solve the problems of sin, death, and curses. Only Jesus, who bore the sins and curses of all people, shed His blood, died, and rose again, is the true counselor who solved all these problems.

He is a mighty God. The apostle Paul testified of God's appearance as a man:

"And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory."(1 Timothy 3:16)

No one can argue with the fact that Jehovah God became a man. No matter how much we argue over and over again, we cannot solve this great mystery.

The apostle Paul concluded that only those who have the Holy Spirit can believe that Jesus is God:

"Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost."(1 Corinthians 12:3)

Another mysterious fact is that Jesus is the Eternal Father. Jesus said that he was one with the Father:

"My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

28 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.

<sup>29</sup> My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.

30 I and my Father are one."(John 10:27-30)

Isaiah prophesied that he would be called the ruler of peace:

"Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this."(Isaiah 9:7)

Jesus spoke through the prophet Isaiah to fulfill what he said:

"The land of Zabulon, and the land of Nephthalim, by the way of the sea, beyond Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles:

16 The people which sat in darkness saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up.

<sup>17</sup> From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."(Matt.4:15-17) '

Even now, the rulers of the world are still uniting to create an organization called the United Nations to make the world peaceful, but in the 6,000 years of human history, peace has never been achieved in the world. Now the United

Nations has declared Agenda 2030 and insists on resetting the New World Order by 2030 to turn the whole world into a peaceful utopia. But sooner or later the Antichrist will appear and deceive the whole world, claiming to be God, and trying to destroy God's people Israel on the earth, but after the seven-year tribulation, the Lord Jesus Christ, the King of righteousness and the Prince of Peace, will appear and throw the beast and the false prophet into the lake of fire to judge and establish the millennial kingdom of peace on this earth:

" And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army. <sup>20</sup> And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone."(Revelation 19:19-20)
