Meditation of the Week: Psalm 91:1-16  
Text: Romans 5; 1-5  
Title: **The Peaceful Life of Those Who Have Peace with God**

The apostle Paul testified of those who have peace with God and the life of hope they enjoy:

**" Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:  
2 By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God."(Romans 5:1-2)**

People living in the world, whether they are individuals or nations, are all pursuing a peaceful life. However, peace between individuals or between nations is a peace that may be broken at any time depending on the situation. However, peace with God is the eternal peace that God gives us in the Holy Spirit through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.

Jesus spoke to his disciples about the peace he gave:

**"Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid."(John 14:27)**

The apostle Paul testified that making peace with God is a blessing for those who enter God's kingdom:

**" For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost."(Romans 14:17)**

He also testified of the joy they enjoy in the Holy Spirit:

**".And because of Him we go forth in faith in this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God.(Romans 5:2)**

To rejoice in the hope of God's glory means to live and rejoice in the only hope of waiting for the glorious appearance of the Lord Jesus Christ.

The apostle Paul testified of the specific life of Christians who rejoice in His glorious hope and are at peace with God:

**"And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience;  
4 And patience, experience; and experience, hope:  
5 And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us."(Romans 5:3-5)**

He also testified of another blessing for those who have peace with God:

**" If God be for us, who can be against us?**

**<sup>32</sup> He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?**

**<sup>33</sup> Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth.**

**<sup>34</sup> Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.**

**<sup>35</sup> Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?**

**<sup>36</sup> As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.**

**<sup>37</sup> Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.**

**<sup>38</sup> For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come,**

**<sup>39</sup> Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord."(Romans 8:31-39)**

However, the world's politicians are deceiving people by shouting with the

United Nations that they will create a peaceful and safe world by fabricating lies about the peace they cannot give.

But God will judge them when they say they are at peace and safe:

**" For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape."(1 Thessalonians 5:3)**

The prophet Daniel prophesied that in the last days, someone, the Antichrist, a man of sin and the Son of Destruction, would appear and deceive people with peace:

**"And in the latter time of their kingdom, when the transgressors are come to the full, a king of fierce countenance, and understanding dark sentences, shall stand up.**

**<sup>24</sup> And his power shall be mighty, but not by his own power: and he shall destroy wonderfully, and shall prosper, and practise, and shall destroy the mighty and the holy people.**

**<sup>25</sup> And through his policy also he shall cause craft to prosper in his hand; and he shall magnify himself in his heart, and by peace shall destroy many: he shall also stand up against the Prince of princes; but he shall be broken without hand."(Dan. 8:23-25)**
