Meditation of the Week: Psalm 91:1-16

Text: Psalm 83:1-18

Title: **God curses him who curses Abraham**

Asaph, plotted cunning against the Lord's people, and counseled against those whom the Lord had hidden, saying, "**Come, and let us cut them off from being a nation; that the name of Israel may be no more in remembrance.**" He appealed to God while listing the countries one by one.

The Holy Spirit foresaw the nations and nations that curse Israel today and made them pray through Asaph. Asaph appealed to God while remembering the words of promise he had given to his ancestor Abraham a long time ago.

**"And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed."****Genesis 12:3)**

God saw that God fulfilled the promise He made to Abraham about the wicked Iran, the leader of the nations that cursed Israel.

God had the prophet Jeremiah prophesy about Iran in the region of Elam:

**"The word of the Lord that came to Jeremiah the prophet against Elam in the beginning of the reign of Zedekiah king of Judah, saying,**

**<sup>35</sup> Thus saith the Lord of hosts; Behold, I will break the bow of Elam, the chief of their might.**

**<sup>36</sup> And upon Elam will I bring the four winds from the four quarters of heaven, and will scatter them toward all those winds; and there shall be no nation whither the outcasts of Elam shall not come.**

**<sup>37</sup> For I will cause Elam to be dismayed before their enemies, and before them that seek their life: and I will bring evil upon them, even my fierce anger, saith the Lord; and I will send the sword after them, till I have consumed them:"****(Jeremiah 49:34-37)**

Just as Haman was killed on the gallows during the reign of King Ahasuerus of Persia, the dictator of today's Iran, through the combined forces of Israel and the United States during Purim, just as Haman was killed on the gallows while he was plotting to exterminate the Jews in the past. If there is even one person who curses Abraham's

descendants, He is a God who curses. Iran brutally persecuted not only Israel but also millions of underground church members in Iran.

The apostle Paul testified that Christians who believed in the Lord Jesus Christ and were born again were also the descendants of Abraham (Galatians 3:7). Therefore, God curses those who persecute Israel and the Church of God.

The prophet Jeremiah said that God would set up his throne in Elam and destroy its kings and dignitaries from there.

Through what is happening in Iran, God is telling us in advance that the establishment of His kingdom in all the earth, including Iran, is near.

We should discern what kind of prayer we should pray to God when we look at the situation in Iran.

First, we must intercede for God's people, Israel, to return to their Messiah, the Lord Jesus Christ, and pray that the members of the underground church in Iran will preach the gospel to all the land of Iran at this time.

Not only that, but we should also pray for Korea. Politicians who do not know God are making laws to

destroy the church of God and cursing the church where Abraham's descendants are located, bringing God's curse upon themselves.

Jeremiah's prophecy has not yet been fully fulfilled to this day. He broke the bow of Elam, but he did not bring the four winds of heaven and scatter them. However, we must pray for the people living in Iran and the members of the underground church and intercede so that even one more person can be saved. Also, before the kingdom where God's throne is established, we must live day by day, looking at the rapture and great tribulation that will come sooner or later, and keep our faith firmly in the word.
