Meditation of the Week: Psalm 91:1-16
Text: Hebrews 1:1-3

Title: **God spoke through His Son in the last days**

Jesus said that when the Holy Spirit comes, He will rebuke the world of sin and righteousness and judgment:

"And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

⁹ Of sin, because they believe not on me;

¹⁰ Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more;

¹¹ Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged."

_(John 16:8-11).

When He said that it was because the ruler of this world was judged, He was saying that the devil, who had the power over sin and death through his death and resurrection, would be judged and could no longer have power. He said that all the sins of the world would be crucified in His own body, and that by overcoming the power of death through His resurrection, the devil would be judged and would no longer be able to become the ruler of this world.

The last days will be the day when the devil will be judged and Jesus Christ will return to the earth and cast the devil into the lake of fire to execute the judgment, that is, the day when the church of God will be raptured, and the judgment on the devil will be executed after the seven-year great tribulation. God spoke to His disciples on the Mount of Olives to speak about the last days:

⁴ And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.

⁵ For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many.

⁶ And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet.

⁷ For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places.

⁸ All these are the beginning of sorrows.

⁹ Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake.

¹⁰ And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another.

¹¹ And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many.

¹² And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.

¹³ But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

¹⁴ And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come."(Matthew 24:4-14)

John the Baptist said of Jesus Christ, **"The Lamb of God, which takes away the sin of the world."**(John 1:29). The apostle Paul addressed the Hebrews about Jesus Christ, saying, **"He himself purged our sins."**(Hebrews 1:3). Since there is eternal life in the blood of Christ in Jesus Christ, whoever has the blood of Christ sprinkled in his conscience, sins will be

removed through the forgiveness and purification of sins.

Jesus once said, though the Jews did not realize it at the time:

"Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you. "(John 6:53)

The apostle Paul testified to the Hebrews that He had established His Son, Jesus Christ, as the heir of all things, and that through Him He had created the worlds. He also testified to the Saints in Colossae:

"For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:

¹⁷ And he is before all things, and by him all things consist."(Colossians 1:16-17)

He also testified that the Church of God, as his bride, would inherit all things together with him:

"And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.

¹⁸ For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us."(Romans 8:17-18)

Jesus Christ is the one who sits at the right hand of God's throne by shedding the blood of the God who cleanses all sins by all the people of the world. However, He will come again to judge those who do not believe in Him until the end of the world. In this regard, God the Father spoke to him through the mouth of David:

"The Lord said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.

² The Lord shall send the rod of thy strength out of Zion: rule thou in the midst of thine enemies."(Psalm 110:1-2)

During the Great Tribulation, He will preach the gospel of the kingdom to all nations through evangelists and one hundred and forty-four thousand Jews, and He will appear at the end of the world and establish His kingdom.

Jesus expressed His will in the prayer he gave to the Jews:

"After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

¹⁰ Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven."(Matthew 6:9-10)
