Meditation of the Week: Psalm 91:1-16
Text: 2 Timothy 3:16-17

Title: **All the Scriptures Inspired by God**

To understand the deep meaning of God's inspiration in His words is wisdom among wisdom and the understanding of understanding. In order to understand the will of God, we must look at the first book of the Bible, Genesis.

God made man in His image and likeness:

"And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

²⁷ So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them."9Genesis 1:26-27)

The Lord God made man out of the dust of the earth and breathed the breath of life into his nostrils, and man became a living soul (Genesis 2:7).

God created man under His own inspiration. But when the first man, Adam and Eve, could not overcome the temptation of the serpent and ate the fruit of the tree of knowledge of good and evil, they died. Their bodies were still alive, but the breath of life disappeared from their spirits, and they were no longer living souls, but dead souls, and spiritually dead. In other words, they lost the image of God.

Adam and Eve had their children, but they were no longer images of God, but of their own:

"And Adam lived an hundred and thirty years, and begat a son in his own likeness, and after his image; and called his name Seth:"(Genesis 5:3)

After the first man lost the image of God due to his sin, many people were born into the world over the past 6,000 years, and 8 billion of people are now living on earth.

Moses, the man of God, prophesied that the years of those born into the world would be seventy years, and if they were strong, they would be eighty (Psalm 90:10).

People think that people are born and grow old and live to be 70 or 80 years old and then die, but in fact, a child born to a person who has lost the image of God does not die of old age, but dies spiritually at birth, so he grows old and dies with his body.

The God of love saw that all Adam's descendants were spiritually dead, and He planned to save them. The fact that all the Bible was inspired by God means that God breathed the breath of life that He breathed into Adam in His words, and He planned to breathe the breath of life into those who believe in Him while reading, studying, and meditating on the words of the Bible, so that He would revive the dead spirit and save the soul to recreate it into a living soul.

Realizing this, the apostle John testified of the word of God from the beginning:

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

² The same was in the beginning with God.

³ All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made."(John 1:1-3)

In the beginning, God, who was in the Word, appeared in the name of Jesus and said, "**For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son, that whoever believes in him may not perish but have eternal life.(John 3; 16)**

He testified to God's love of salvation by breathing the Holy Spirit, the breath of God's life, into those who believe in Himself, by reading, studying, and meditating on all the words of the Bible that He has revealed.

The apostle Paul testified to this when he spoke to his disciple Timothy:

"And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus."(2 Timothy 3:15)

And he testified to the purpose of writing the Bible, which was infused with the Spirit of God:

"All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

¹⁷ That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works."(2 Timothy 3:16-17)

Jesus testified to Nicodemus that a person cannot enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Holy Spirit (John 3:5), and that the apostle Peter testified to be born again by the word of God when he speaks of being born again:

"Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

²⁴ For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away:

²⁵ But the word of the Lord endureth for ever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you."(1 Peter 1:23-25)

God saves the dead spirit by breathing into His Word the breath of life that He took because of the sin of the first man, so that anyone who believes in Jesus Christ revealed in God's word will breathe the breath of life that gives him eternal life, so that the dead spirit will be revived and the soul that is spiritually dead will be saved to become a living soul.
Amen! Hallelujah!
