This Week's Meditation: Psalm 91:1-16

Text: Ezekiel 9:1-11

Scripture Title: God Marked Those Who Lament and Wail Over Abominations

God called the man who had filled the ink can and said:

"Pass through the city. Pass through the middle of Jerusalem and mark the foreheads of those who groan and weep over all the abominations done in it. "(Ezekiel 9:4)

He also spoke to others:

"Pursue him and march through the city, but do not spare your eyes or show mercy. Kill every woman, old or young, maiden or child, but do not approach anyone with a mark, and begin in my sanctuary.' ' So they began with the old man in front of the temple. The Lord said to them, 'Defile the temple and fill the courtyard with the murdered.' 'Go out.' 'So they went out and killed him in the city.' (Ezekiel 9:5-7)

The Apostle Paul testified about what believers ought to do:

"Do not be yoked with unbelievers. How can righteousness be in relation to unrighteousness, and how can light associate with darkness? How can Christ be in harmony with Belial, and what part can a believer be with an unbeliever? How can God's temple and its idols be united? For you are the temple of the living God. God also says, 'I will live among them and walk among them; I will be their God, and they will be my people. Therefore the Lord says: Leave yourself apart from them and do not touch any impurity. Then I will receive you, and I will be your Father to you, and you will be my sons and daughters. Thus says the Almighty Lord. ' (2 Corinthians 6:14-18)

Those who do not believe belong to all religions that have not received forgiveness for sins by believing in the blood of Jesus Christ, who is God. Anyone who belongs to God's church but associates with people of other religions is committing abominable acts before God. Just as righteousness is associated with injustice and light cannot associate with darkness.

Christ and Belial are enemies, yet they cannot be united in any way with any religious person who

worships Belial. How can a person who believes in Christ, received the Holy Spirit, and become God's temple, be united with other religions that worship idols? God hates idolatry the most.

Therefore, God's church must be separate from them and must not touch the filthy sins among them.

Today, most of God's churches around the world, including Korea, are carrying out all the abominable acts that were done among the Israelites long ago during the time of the prophet Ezekiel. It is precisely the WCC, WEA, and NCCK infiltrating the church, pretending to be peaceful, loving, and inclusive, and committing abominable acts that claim the Church of God will unite with Roman Catholicism and all other religions.

Even while witnessing these abominations, most Christians participate in this abominable act due to spiritual ignorance.

We must realize how abominationous things that happened in the time of the prophet Ezekiel and the ecumenical movement for

religious integration now are truly abominable in God's eyes.

In the time of the ancient prophet Ezekiel, God marked the foreheads of those who groaned and cried out because of all the abominations done in Jerusalem, and He struck all others without sparing their eyes or showing mercy, instructing them to kill all women, whether old or young, virgins or children, and not to approach those with marks, but to begin in God's sanctuary. He also commanded to fill the courtyard with those who defiled and killed the temples.

It is time to seriously consider what God is saying as He watches over the abominations happening in Korea and worldwide through the WCC, WEA, and NCCK, and to listen closely to the voice God gives to each of us. Christians who participate in the abominable acts carried out through them are, in fact, those who have turned away from faith in Jesus Christ. Now is also the time to awaken those who are spiritually ignorant. Amen! Hallelujah!
